The Lynn Housing Authority & Neighborhood Development (LHAND) will be distributing applications for the **TWO BEDROOM – WHEELCHAIR ACCESIBLE WAITING LIST** for units at the Curwin Circle Family Public Housing Program. Please note, that if you do not require a physically modified unit, you will be not be placed on the Waiting List

APPLICATIONS WILL BE DISTRIBUTED MONDAY, APRIL 11, 2011 TO FRIDAY, MAY 6, 2011 AT THE ADMISSIONS OFFICE, 174 S. COMMON STREET (CAGGIANO PLAZA), LYNN, MA. APPLICATIONS WILL BE GIVEN OUT BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 8:00 A.M. – 4:00 P.M. MONDAY, WEDNESDAY, AND THURSDAY, AND 8:00 A.M. TO 7:00 P.M. TUESDAY, AND 8:00 A.M. TO 12:30 P.M. FRIDAY.

COMPLETED APPLICATIONS WILL BE CONSIDERED IF MAILED IN AND POSTMARKED PRIOR TO AND INCLUDING MAY 6, 2011. HAND-DELIVERED APPLICATIONS WILL ALSO BE CONSIDERED PRIOR TO AND INCLUDING MAY 6, 2011. APPLICATIONS RECEIVED AFTER THIS DATE WILL BE INELIGIBLE. FAXED, PHOTOCOPIED AND E-MAILED APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

Eligible applicants will be placed on an existing waiting list. Placement on the waiting list will be by lottery method and *NOT ON A FIRST COME FIRST SERVE BASIS*, as well as, by the appropriate preference/priority category. All applicants must require the use of a physically modified unit. Verification of this need may be required

You may be eligible if your annual gross income is less than:

\$45,100.00	\$51,550.00	\$58,000.00	\$64,400.00

These income limits are subject to HUD regulations. Applicants must also meet the occupancy standards established by the Lynn Housing Authority & Neighborhood Development and the Department of Housing & Urban Development.
